

BSLC Treasurer's Summary

For the month of August our income was \$15,573.50 on a budget of \$21, 150.00. Income was \$5576.50 below budget for the month. Our expenses were \$17,764.57 on a budget of \$18,540.59 which was \$776.02 under budgeted expenses. The income for August was \$2,191.07 less than expenses. Giving for August continues to be down from our projected income. As we enter the call process, we will need to dedicate a budget for that in the next few months as well as keeping up with our current expenses, so I ask all members to continue to faithfully keep up your giving and if you are able to give more to help our current needs. It would most definitely be appreciated and needed. We also need to begin funding a Property Insurance Deductible dedicated account, so if you would like to contribute to that fund, it would also be appreciated. Once we have the deductible amount saved, we will be in good shape should we have need for an insurance claim on our property from any damage that occurs. I believe as we are now getting back to a more normal worship and activities at our Church, our income will also begin to get back to more normal levels. I am thankful to a good and gracious God and for all of you in our Congregation. I know we all want to remain a strong Congregation together!

May God continue to watch over us all and keep us safe and healthy and ready to serve in mission together, Amen.




