BSLC Treasurer's Summary November 12, 2020

For the month of October our income was \$18,052.05 on a budget of \$21, 150.00. Income was \$3097.50 below budget for the month. Our expenses were \$25,249.62 on a budget of \$24,393.20 which was \$856.42 over budgeted expenses. The income for October was \$7,197.57 less than expenses. Giving for October is still down from our projected income, however it has increased over September by almost \$2,000.00 which again is a positive sign. The Call Committee has already begun their work towards the search for a new Pastor, so it remains important for us all to continue to faithfully keep up or increase our giving to keep our Church financially healthy through the call period and beyond. Also please remember there is a need for giving to fund a Property Insurance Deductible dedicated account, and I express thank you to those who have already given to this fund! With the current COVID19 surge in our area, we all need to stay connected and focused on remaining the strong Congregation we all know and love. I pray we are able to continue to help our Church move forward successfully through this challenging pandemic time. Each one of you make a difference in our Church and I appreciate you all!

May God continue to watch over us all and keep us safe and healthy and ready to serve in mission together, Amen.


