Evangelism:

Fellowship: The Fellowship committee will be meeting to plan activities with social distancing.

Social Concerns

Meals on Wheels continue to deliver meals to 6 -10 people weekly by 4 dedicated members.

Food pantry continues distributing meals supplies weekly. The week prior to Christmas, six precipitants were given turkeys.

No ramps were built in December. On behalf of BSLC, \$500.00 donation was given as a yearly gift to the Texas Ramp Project. This covers the cost of one ramp.

Helping Hands provided rental assistance to one family early in the year.

The sewing group created 650 Christmas stockings. These were given to The Childrens' Home, Jan Werner, Thomas E. Creek VA Nursing Home, Ussary Roan Texas State Nursing Home, Georgia Manor Nursing Home, Medical Lodge Nursing Home, Domestic Violence Center and to Meals on Wheels. Due to current Health guidelines, the Christmas party was cancelled.

Treasurer's Summary

14,005.85

For the month of December our income was \$25,036.50 on a budget of \$21, 150.00. This is \$3886.50 over budgeted income (approx \$3500 was actually November income that was not deposited until December 1 but even with that we still were over anticipated income by almost \$400.00). Our expenses were \$14,005.85 on a budget of \$19,093.27 which was \$\$5,087.42 under budgeted expenses. The income for the month was \$11,030.65 more than expenses. The Call Committee process is well in progress and the Call Committee continues to work on the search for our next Pastor. So far, the Congregation has given \$1450.00 towards the Call process! And in addition, we have received \$1600.00 to our Insurance Deductible fund! Thank you to those that have given to these funds. I thank each one of our Council members this year for excellent work in managing expenses during this very challenging year. It definitely has helped us to end the year in much better financial shape than it might have been. I pray that the New Year of 2021 will be a much better year for our Church, Congregation and our Council and that we can get back to the serving our Mission and those in need. Each one of you make a difference in our Church and I appreciate you all!






